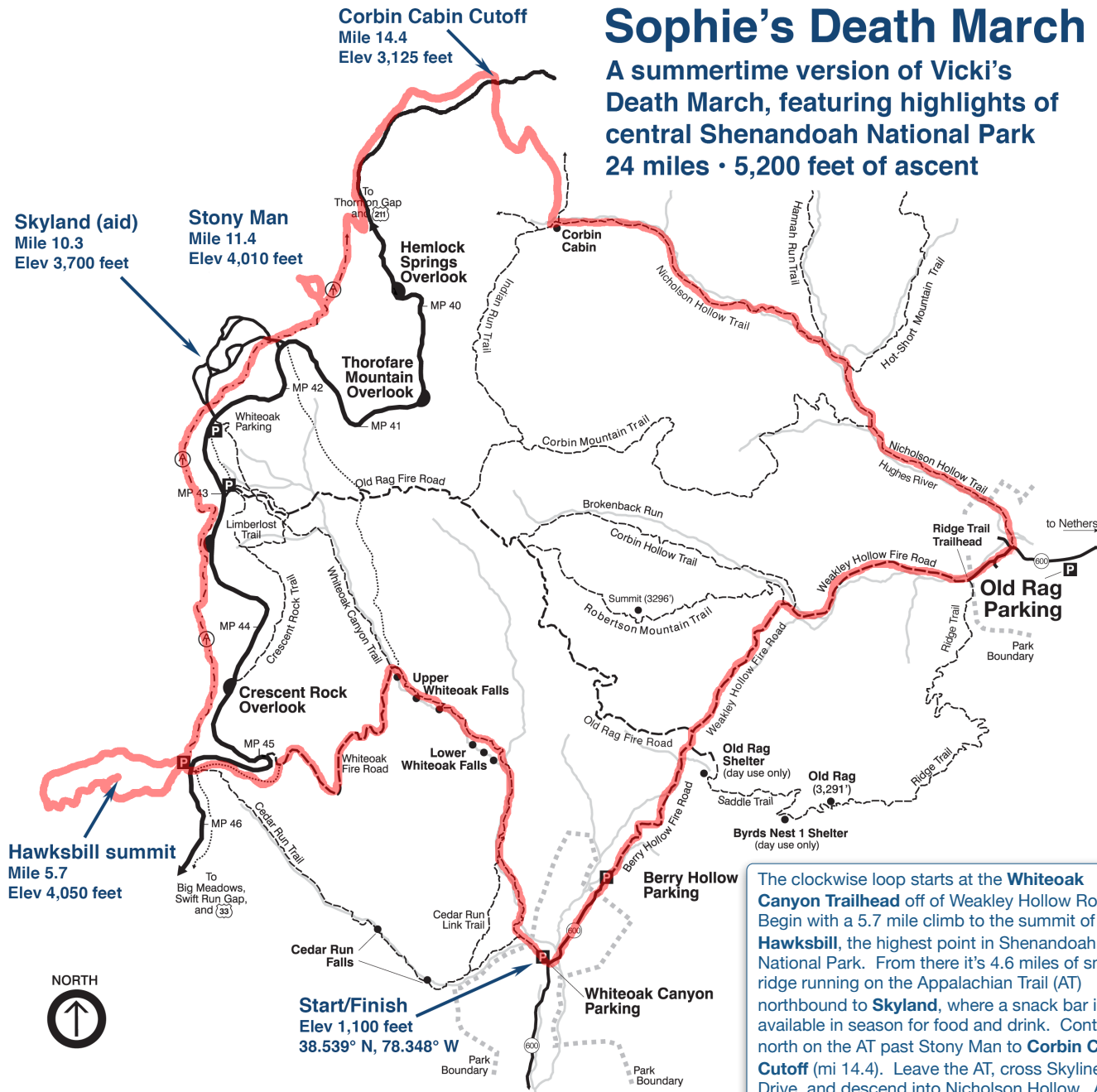


Sophie's Death March

A summertime version of Vicki's Death March, featuring highlights of central Shenandoah National Park
24 miles • 5,200 feet of ascent



The clockwise loop starts at the **Whiteoak Canyon Trailhead** off of Weakley Hollow Road. Begin with a 5.7 mile climb to the summit of **Hawksbill**, the highest point in Shenandoah National Park. From there it's 4.6 miles of smooth ridge running on the Appalachian Trail (AT) northbound to **Skyland**, where a snack bar is available in season for food and drink. Continue north on the AT past Stony Man to **Corbin Cabin Cutoff** (mi 14.4). Leave the AT, cross Skyline Drive, and descend into Nicholson Hollow. At **State Route 600** (paved, mi 19.6), take a right and join **Weakley Hollow Fire Road** at the Old Rag Trailhead. Follow this and the **Berry Hollow Fire Road** back to Whiteoak Canyon. Numerous fire roads and other trails offer shortcuts, particularly from Skyland or Corbin Cabin.
